(B6T) Nonpublic School Transportation Application (N.J.A.C 6A:27-2.5)

<u>Instructions</u>

It is the obligation of the parent or guardian of nonpublic school students to annually obtain the Nonpublic School Transportation Application from the administrative office of the nonpublic school for each student for which transportation services are being requested. Submit a separate application for each student.

Note:

- If there is a change of home address, a new application shall be submitted to the public school district of residence.
- If there is a change in the nonpublic school of attendance, a new application shall be submitted to the public school district of residence.
- Complete this application and return it to the nonpublic school on or before March 10th preceding the school year in which transportation is being requested.
- Late applications Any application received after March 10th will be a late application and must be accompanied by a statement of the reason for lateness. Eligible students will receive transportation or aid in lieu of transportation based on the date the application is received by the public school.
- It is the obligation of the nonpublic school administrator to annually collect the application and submit it to the public school district from which transportation is being requested prior to March 15th.
- It is the obligation of the public school administrator to notify the parent or guardian as the determination of each application by August 1st.
- A district board of education shall pay aid in lieu of transportation to the parent or guardian of an eligible student only after receiving a signed "Nonpublic School Transportation Payment" voucher (B7T) as prescribed by the Commissioner of Education.



The Mountain Lakes Police Department recommends the following procedures Morning drop-off and Afternoon pick-up

- All vehicles enter Laurel Hill Road from Martin's Lane and travel south on Laurel to the School.
- All vehicles turn left onto Tower Hill Road when exiting the school driveway.
- Buses may drop off in school driveway, but they must pick up at Island Beach.
- Numbered parking spaces are for Craig employees only.
- Visitor parking is for up to one hour. If you are staying at the school longer, please park across the street at the beach.
- Tower Hill Road is off limits on both sides of the street for parking, stopping and standing.
- Laurel Hill Road is off limits for parking, stopping and standing.
- Due to the congestion of the parking lot, we ask that you do not leave your car unattended.
- Please make every effort to keep the car line moving.
- Please continue using Martin's Lane traffic pattern. Tower Hill Road is a one-way (out) between 2:20 PM and 3:20 PM. This is enforced by the Mountain Lakes Police Department.
- Please do not line up for pick-up before 2:50 PM. (If you are early, please park across the street at the beach while waiting.)
- Please do not block our neighbor's driveways.

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Lower/Middle School Supply List 2024-2025

The Craig School provides students with binders that are a part of our school wide organizational system.

Please have your child bring the following items on the first day of school:

Please note: We ask that children **NOT** bring in any toys, trading cards, fidget spinners, hand-held electronic games, etc. unless otherwise notified. We find these items very distracting to our children in the classroom. Classrooms are supplied with fidgets for students to use should they be beneficial to learning.

Lockers: All students will *share* a locker where they can store their backpacks, lunch, and coats. We do not use locks on our lockers. We know it has become popular to decorate lockers at the beginning of the year, please keep in mind this year lockers will be shared and will not be assigned until the first day of school.

Electronic Devices/Cell Phones/Smart Devices: When students arrive at school their cell phones MUST remain in their backpacks. Once they arrive at homeroom, faculty will ask students to place cell phones or other electronic devices not being used for academic learning in a designated place. The homeroom teachers at the end of the day will return all devices to students before dismissal. If a student is arriving late to school, they can turn their phone in to their homeroom teacher before the start of their day.

Students are not permitted to text others or call using their electronic devices during the academic day-including calls to parents and guardians. Students may only place phone calls to parents/guardians from the social clinician's or the nurse's office.
